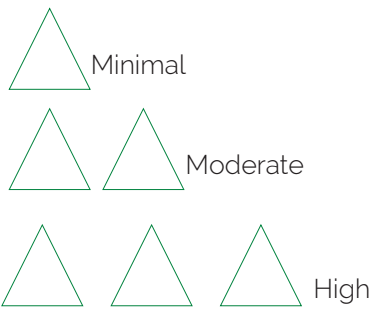


Scale out of 3 triangles:

Classroom-Based Programs

Programs delivered to students during a traditional school day.

After School

Programs delivered to students outside traditional school hours, including afternoons, evenings, weekends, and summer.

Event-Based Programs

Programs in which students participate a day-long, out-of-classroom, volunteer-led experience.

Head Start: Boosting Your Employability

(Event-Based)

Age Range: 18-24

Head Start meets the needs of a diverse group of university students by providing engaging, academically enriching, and experiential learning sessions in work-readiness education and career perspectives.

The workshop-based program includes three volunteer-led sessions covering resume writing, the science and art of interviewing, and an introduction to internships (what they mean, how to be well prepared for a good internship, and how to handle work duties during an internship.)
