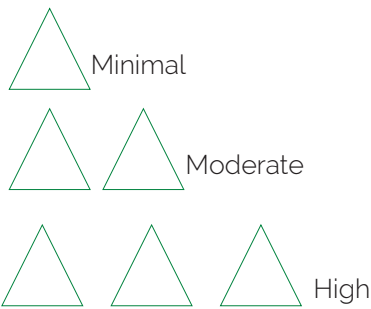




Scale out of 3 triangles:
