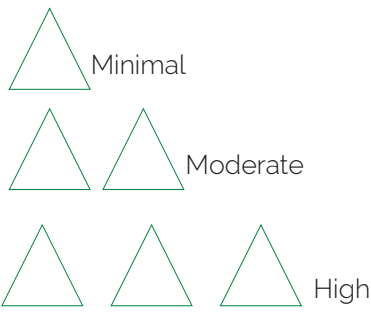


Scale out of 3 triangles:

### Classroom-Based Programs

# Personal Economics Program

(Classroom-Based)

Age Range: 12-14

Language: Arabic/English

Program Duration: 7 sessions (50 mins)

Students per Group: 32

The Personal Economics program is designed to give 14-12 year old students a hands-on, practical introduction to personal finance, credit and debt, savings and investments, and budgeting.

The program aims to encourage students to appreciate their current and future role in society and the economy as consumers, employees and employers, investors and borrowers. Volunteers from the working world lead discussions, deliver activities, and enrich the program with their own experiences and knowledge.
